


## The GateKeeper Proximity Difference



### GATEKEEPER PROXIMITY

#### Save time while logging in

Nothing to tap or swipe. As long as you have your key with you, authentication is instant and automatic. Seamless login.



#### Automatic lock and auto-fill

Instead of timeout policies that either interrupt or are too slow to be effective, GateKeeper auto-locks instantly.



#### Lower cost of ownership

Users of GateKeeper generally earn back their investment within 2 to 3 months. Removing password problems saves money.



#### Login to any PC without passwords

Unlike scanning a card, GateKeeper automates the entire process—your personal password caddy.



#### No more downtime

GateKeeper helps users access PCs and websites with zero input to save maximum time and prevent downtime.



### RFID CARDS

#### Takes too many steps—friction

Tapping is one too many extra steps. Have to remove gloves to reach for the card—not PPE friendly. Not hygienic.

#### Ineffective Timeout Policies

Trouble with RFID is that it only logs you in. Relying on the user to lock the PC when they leave is capricious.

#### Expensive and hard to maintain

Readers for each PC is cost-prohibitive. Each reader requires firmware updates. Too many lost cards is a security risk.

#### Not multi-PC friendly

Setting up at every workstation is time-consuming and annoying. Login is slow and not instant. Too many usability issues.

#### Reliability and security issues

Tag collisions, reader quality, card failure, DOS attacks, tag cloning attacks. If the reader breaks, there's no way in.

**GateKeeper automatically locks when the user walks away.**

**No unlocked workstations! Impossible with RFID authentication.**
